The Town Hall office is open week days from 10:00 a. m. to 1:00 p. m. A volunteer will be present to assist you. Or contact a Board member and request a membership application.

The Town Hall office is closed the entire month of July.

Proof of property ownership in Placid Lakes Subdivision is needed to become a member and to obtain a gate key to Tobler Park. Proof of ownership can be one of the following: a current property tax bill, a closing statement or a deed of property ownership. In addition you will need to provide a photo ID such as a current driver license.

Current members may renewal their membership without proof of ownership.

The membership volunteer fee is \$25.00. The Association will accept check payments or cash.
